The consent is granted under section 25 / 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 to operate the project in Mauza Adityapur Industrial Area, P.O. - i. That, the occupier shall comply with all conditions of CTE Ref. No. **G-114** Ranchi, Dated **06.01.2013** shall submit report to this effect with supporting documents.
- ii. That, the occupier shall maintain the ambient air quality within the standard given below:

- iv. That, the occupier shall keep D G Set(s) within acoustic enclosure (s) and shall keep the height(s) of exhaust pipe(s) as per Central Pollution Control Board norm.
- v. That, the occupier shall keep process effluent in close-circuit and the quality of effluent from other sources in conformity with the standard (s) and the discharge quantity as below:

- vi. That, the occupier shall install and maintain Central Ground Water Board/ State Ground Water Directorate approved system of rain water harvesting-cum-ground water recharge.
- vii. That, the occupier shall create and maintain new water body (ies) / remove deposit(s) of existing water body(ies)/ nearby stream(s) and pond(s) and well(s) and shall maintain the wholesomeness of water.
- viii. That, the occupier shall dispose of solid wastes as follows:

- ix. That, the occupier shall grow and maintain greenery in the periphery and other available spaces and shall continue enhancing its plant density and biodiversity.
- x. That, the occupier shall submit environmental statement with supporting stochiometric calculations analyses reports, every year.
- xi. That, the occupier shall submit report(s) duly monitored and issued by an NABL accredited laboratory in compliance of sub-para (ii), (iii), (v) and (viii) of general condition monthly/ quarterly/ six monthly/ annually.
 - xii. That, the occupier shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977; the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981; and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules there under.

(B). Specific Conditions:

- i. That, the occupier shall install and operate systems for online monitoring of ambient air quality and stack emission and effluent quality with connectivity to Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board server.
- ii. That, the occupier shall establish and operate well equipped environmental laboratory with facilities to monitor at least all regulatory parameters and duly accredited by NABL.
- iii. That, the occupier shall operate and maintain air pollution control equipment such as fume extraction system, Bag filters, Cyclone separators regularly.
- iv. That, the occupier shall make necessary arrangement for control of secondary fugitive emission and shall follow the guidelines/code of practice issued by Central Pollution Control Board.
- v. That, the occupier shall not use charcoal as fuel and Pet coke shall be used as fuel.
- vi. That, the total water requirement shall not exceed 1.5 m³/day.
- vii. That, the occupier shall utilize slag produced in Ferro-Manganese production in manufacture of Silica Manganese and shall utilize other ferro alloy slag in the preparation of building materials.
- viii. That, the occupier shall not utilize ferro chrome without prior approval from Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change.
- ix. That, the occupier shall comply all the conditions mentioned in environmental clearance and NOC within one month.
- x. That, the occupier shall submit applications for renewal of consent under section 25 / 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 again 120 days prior to the date of expiry of this consent i.e. 30.09.2015, with requisite fee and documents showing compliance of all of the above conditions.
- 4. This order shall be valid subject to all compliance(s)/statutory clearance (s) under all other applicable laws to the unit.
